

The origin of the name

The Surgeon's Domus, or House, was the home and professional surgery of a rich doctor from Ariminum who lived in the II century A.D. His name was Eutyches and he was most likely of oriental origins. A doctor and a pharmacist, he carried out his activity in two rooms of the abode, decorated with magnificent floor mosaics. Housed in the nearby City Museum are his 150 bronze surgical instruments which survived a fire that destroyed the Domus in the III century A.D., and which make up the most complete collection in the world. This archaeological site also includes a Late-Antique lavish palazzo and the remains of an early Medieval dwelling. These emerged from beneath the garden of one of the old town's main squares in 1989.

After lengthy preparation, the monumental complex was inaugurated in 2007 and has become a major cultural attraction, transforming the image of Rimini as not just a beach resort, but as an authentic art city.
