An elegant and functional room with high quality finishings and furniture throughout. Soundproof and sound-absorbing beech wood walls and cherry wood floors. Standard, ready to go set up and lay out. Thonet linking lecture chairs with maximum comfort can be provided. The room is located on the first floor.

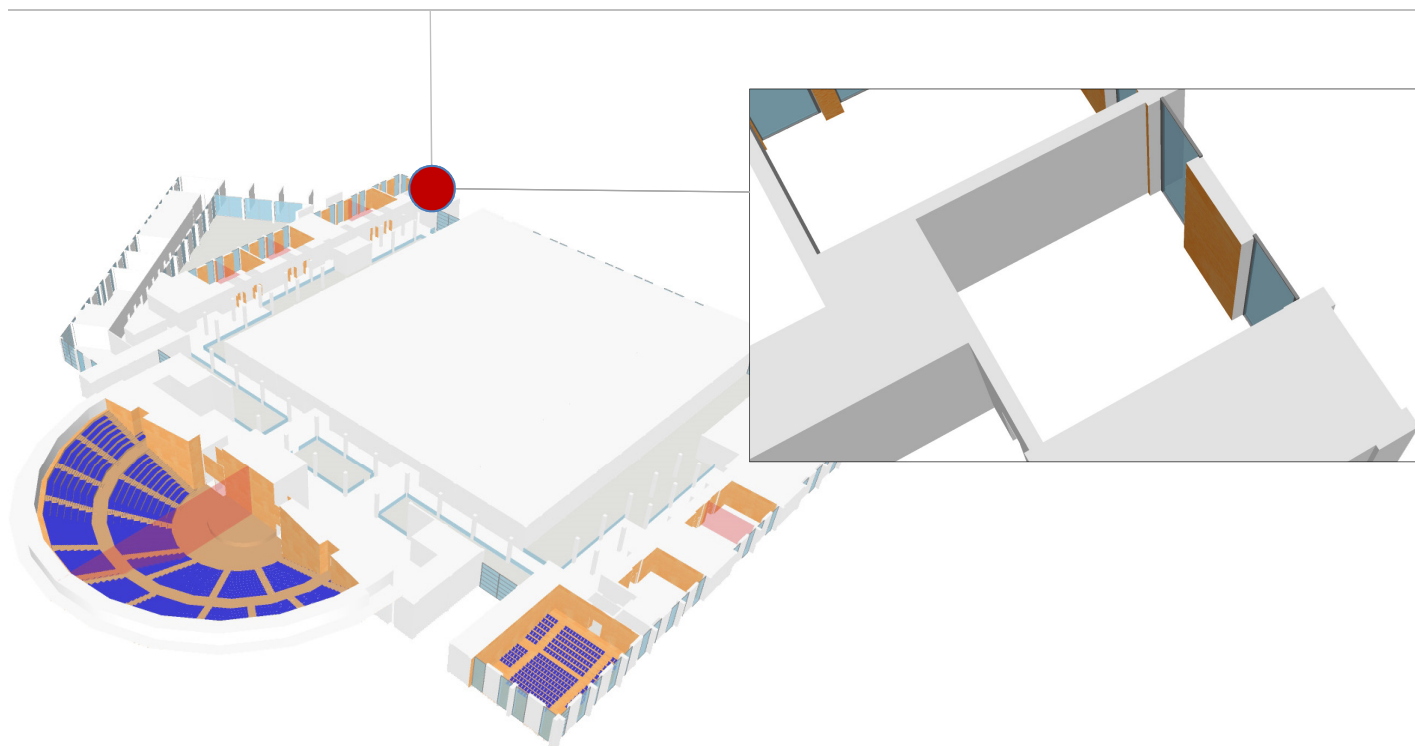
- Natural light and remote controlled blackout facilities

- Presidential table and podium
- Audio amplification system with wired and radio microphones
- Screen and hanging video projection system for front screen projection
- Electrical connections and internet sockets in underfloor outlet boxes or wall outlets
- High density Wi-Fi coverage
- LCD monitor on both Presidential table and podium
- 1 entrance point to the room
- Customisable digital signage at entrance to room

The origin of the name

The Vecchia Pescheria Room takes its name from the old fish market which opens onto Piazza Cavour almost like the three naves of a church. The sinuous spirals that unite its surroundings betray its Baroque origins: it was designed in 1747 by Rimini architect, Giovan Francesco Buonamici. As the inscription on its facades recalls, this Porticus Piscarias was funded by the local fishermen themselves whose share was determined in proportion to the size of their boat. For centuries, fish was sold on slabs of Istrian stone in this lively market, washed by the water coming from the four corner fountains in the shape of leaping fish.
