







PALACONGRESS TO HOST ISBS 2027 INTERNATIONAL SOCIETY OF BIOMECHANICS IN SPORTS

Rimini, 21 February 2025 – Italian Exhibition Group is set to host a new international event, the 45th edition of the International Society of Biomechanics in Sports, at the Palacongressi in Rimini from June 23 to 27, 2027.

The success of the bid, put forward by Unibo, was largely due to the crucial role of the professors involved, in this case, Professor Laura Bragonzoni, Department of Science for Quality of Life at the Rimini Campus, who was recently awarded the Rimini Mundi 2024. In collaboration with IEG, she forged the necessary connections to strengthen Rimini's proposal.

With the new conference that broadens the calendar of the coming years, IEG's presence in events related to the world of sports is further consolidated. Indeed, two other events have already been scheduled with the crucial support of Unibo and the professors at the Rimini Campus: The European College of Sport Science (July 2025) and the European Sport Management Conference (September 2027). The Wellness Valley, the global event RiminiWellness, the open-air gyms at Parco del Mare and the Inside Out area of the Palacongressi were crucial factors in clinching the bid.

"Hosting an international congress on biomechanics in sports, explains Professor Bragonzoni, is a unique opportunity to foster research, innovation, and progress in the fields of motor sciences, movement analysis, and beyond. It brings together over 400 experts, researchers, and professionals from around the world, nurturing a multidisciplinary exchange of knowledge, techniques, and innovative discoveries. This event stimulates international collaborations and new research opportunities. Biomechanics applied to sports can significantly enhance athletes' performance, minimise injury risks, and optimise training methods. Biomechanical analysis can also be applied to daily life and recreational sports, helping to prevent injuries and improve posture and overall fitness. This has a positive impact on public health, promoting healthier lifestyles for a greater number of people."

The ISBS congress, adds Fabio De Santis, IEG's Event & Conference Director, serves as a showcase for new technologies, methodologies, and approaches in biomechanics applied to sports. Advanced motion analysis tools, wearable devices, and simulation software are among the developments being discussed, spotlighting how these innovations can revolutionise training, rehabilitation, and performance. Additionally, in the adjacent exhibition space, we eagerly anticipate the presence of leading international companies in the industry, unveiling their cutting-edge technologies and devices."

The ISBS annual event travels around the globe. In 2024, it was held in Salzburg, this year it will be in Doha (Qatar), next year in Loughborough (UK), then landing in Rimini in 2027.
