CASTELLO ROOM



MAIN CHARACTERISTICS

Elegant and functional, this room can be divided into two separate spaces for parallel sessions. High quality finishings and furniture throughout the room with soundproof and soundabsorbing beech wood walls and cherry wood floors. Standard, ready to go set up and lay out. Thonet linking lecture chairs with maximum comfort can be provided. The room is located on the ground floor.

- Soundproof and sound-absorbing full height beech wood partition walls can divide the room into 2 separate spaces
- Natural light and remote controlled blackout facilities
- Dimmer lights for selected areas
- Standard 2 x 10 m stage with Presidential table and podium
- Lighting truss system for stage with dimmer lights
- Audio amplification system with wired and radio microphones
- Suspended video projection system suitable for various formats for every part of the room
- Front projection system in various sizes and video projector for every part of the room
- 2 component video cameras and 2 video composite cameras
- Fixed hooks for suspended rigging in any part of the room
- Extensive audio, video and lighting connections
- Fixed and mobile video production
- 3 translation booths with simultaneous translation service of up to 16 languages
- High density Wi-Fi coverage
- LCD monitor on both Presidential table and podium
- 2 entrance points to the room
- Customisable digital signage at each entrance to room
- Floor outlets for exhibitions (power supply, sockets)

The origin of the name

The Castello Room takes its name from Castel Sismondo, the residence of the most important member of the Malatesta family, Sigismondo Pandolfo (1419-1468). A brilliant leader, he was the patron of many artists and scholars. He enlisted the help of the renowned Filippo Brunelleschi to transform the stronghold of his ancestors into a formidable fortified construction, capable of withstanding bombardments. The tower still bears a magnificent coat of arms with a crest depicting an elephant against a chequered background. Together with the colourful majolica frieze of roses on another tower, these symbols bear witness to the House of Malatesta, Lords of Rimini from the late 13th to the early 16th century.
