MAIN CHARACTERISTICS

Large and multifunctional, the hall can be sub-divided into six areas to host parallel events. The space can be customised to suit the setting or scale of any event, and its versatile equipment and modular decor are ideal for rapid set-ups and room changes for congresses, shows, catering and exhibition areas. Everything you need to make your event a huge success. The spaces can simultaneously host dinners, concerts, conventions and exhibitions. Thonet linking lecture chairs with maximum comfort can be provided. This space is located on the ground floor.

FEATURES:

• Soundproof and sound-absorbing full height beech wood partition walls can divide the room into 6 separate spaces

- Natural light and remote controlled blackout facilities
- Dimmer lights for selected areas
- Customisable stages of various heights and sizes
- Backstage area with changing rooms and restrooms (150m2)
- Lighting truss system for stage with dimmer lights
- Audio amplification system with wired and radio microphones
- Screen and hanging video projection system for front screen projection in every part of the room
- Tracks, pulleys and fixed hooks for suspended rigging
- Extensive audio, video and lighting connections
- Fixed and mobile video production
- 16 translation booths with simultaneous translation service of up to 16 languages
- High density Wi-Fi coverage
- Direct street access for heavy good vehicles
- 8 entrance points to the room
- Customisable digital signage at each entrance to room
- 84 floor outlets for exhibitions (power supply, sockets)

The origin of the name

The Piazza Hall takes its name from Piazza Cavour, which for centuries has been the beating heart of the city: a meeting place dear to the people of Rimini and centre of local political power, with the City Hall located in Palazzo Grampi. Rimini's long history emerges from the monuments that make up the Piazza - the Medieval municipal buildings, the Renaissance Pigna fountain, the eighteenth century Fish Market and the neoclassical facade of the Town Theatre, providing a backdrop to the magnificent bronze sculpture of Pope Paul V, which dominates the Piazza from its pedestal.
